DVLA SCAM EMAIL

Welcome

We have noticed that your vehicle is no longer up to date with its current road tax.

This is the last (v11) reminder we will issue you.

Currently your vehicle is legally not allowed to be on the road.

You must fill out the form below in order to be up to standard with the DVLA legal requirements.

DVLA Scam doing the rounds this month.

A scam email impersonating the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) tells you that your vehicle is no longer up to date with its current road tax. This can sound credible because we no longer have a tax disc to remind us.

It also includes a warning that this is the last reminder It will issue to you. The START NOW button looks genuine but is in

fact a link to a web page which will encourage you to submit personal or financial information. Fill out a form to be “*up to standard with the DVLA legal requirements.*” Again suggesting that the request has the force of the law behind it.

The fact that the email does not address you by name nor contain any vehicle details should alert you to the fact that this is not genuine. If in any doubt contact the DVLA directly.
